First Warning – a reminder of the rules



Second Warning – another reminder of the rules and what will happen if rules are broken again



Time out – this will happen in the classroom, playground, another classroom or with the Head/Deputy. The time and location will depend upon the situation.



Restore – time to reflect on the and work out how we can make things better/right

Serious situations will go to the time out stage straight away and more serious situations will follow the Positive Behaviour and Exclusions Policy
