Minibus update:

At present the PTA is committed to paying for the ongoing lease of the school minibus. As this seven year lease expires in a few months' time, we've been doing lots of research into our options for the future.

We would love to buy our own minibus, enabling us to free up PTA funds to pay for additional resources and experiences for the children. So, we are currently busy approaching local businesses and organizations with a view to raising donations/grants towards the £35,000 it would cost to buy a minibus. Whilst we have already received a few generous donations, there's still a very long way to go. If you know of an organization that might be willing to help us, please do get in touch. All donations, no matter the size, will be gratefully received.

The minibus is an invaluable asset to the school making over 150 trips each year, allowing our children access to off-site learning and sporting opportunities that wouldn't be possible otherwise. The cost of hiring coaches for these trips would be prohibitive, so the minibus really is a vital resource, though unfortunately not one that can be paid for from the school budget.
