Y5 & Y6 Self Dismissal

Self – dismissing policy

- Children are allowed to self-dismiss at the end of the school day in Year 5 and Year 6.
- Written consent (e-mail) from the parents is needed for this to happen – with details of where they are going to.
- In certain circumstances, a Year 4 sibling might be permitted to be collected by a responsible Year 6 sibling who is self-dismissing. These will be judged on individual cases and will require signed consent from the parent.
- All younger years need to be collected by a parent (or agreed adult with school) from the classroom door.
- Self-dismissal can be removed from a child if there is a cause for concern in relation to the child dismissing themselves. In these circumstances, they will have to revert back to being picked up from the class.
